**Meeting Minutes**

- 1. Call Meeting to Order**
- 2. Review of Minutes** – August meeting minutes approved as reviewed.
- 3. Carolina Show Ski Team** – Charlie Funderburk
  - a. Would like for Parks & Rec to incorporate the Carolina Ski Show Team under the Parks & Rec umbrella as a fully sponsored sport
  - b. Hope MacBride moves “that the Parks & Rec Committee fully sponsors the Carolina Ski Show Team, and their Friday Night Ski Shows. City’s sponsorship should include: Use of Windjammer Park 2 times per week prior to June, and 1 time per week during the months of June, July & August; Friday night ski shows should be permitted by DNR; advertisement/announcements of their shows on the city’s website and in the Parks & Rec newsletter.
  - c. Emily Jaeckli seconds the motion
  - d. Vote is unanimous
  - e. Ski Show team will also begin conceptualizing more learn-to-ski programs for parks & Rec
- 4. Tobacco Ban in City Parks** – Charlie Funderburk
  - a. Ordinance 328 prohibits tobacco products on field during athletic events – would need to amend 328 (which would become an entirely new ordinance) to ban tobacco products in all city parks
  - b. Charlie to e-mail Clover & Greenville ordinances to committee for review.
  - c. Possible motion will be made at the October meeting
- 5. Teen Events** – Charlie Funderburk
  - a. Fifth Quarter – Teen event to be held in the basement of the Glennon Center on Friday nights of away football games
  - b. First one would be Friday, 10/2 from 7-10 PM
  - c. High school students only; doors lock at 7 PM, unlock at 10 PM
  - d. Need 5-8 adults to volunteer
  - e. Charlie to contact Game Stop about a Wii donation
  - f. Will need a CD player and games/cards
  - g. Charlie to coordinate all logistics
